# **BIBLE DISCOVERY (35-45 MINUTES)**

- Big Idea for gGroup: God can do a lot with a few small steps of faith.
- WHAT?
  - Read Judges 6:11-16
    - How did the angel of the LORD describe Gideon in verse 12?
    - What fear was holding Gideon back?
  - o Read Judges 6:17-21
    - Why did Gideon want a sign when other judges went off of God's promise?
  - Read Judges 6:25-32
    - What was Gideon afraid of?
    - Did the men find out who tore down the altar of Baal and the Asherah pole?
    - How was Gideon's life protected?
  - o Read Judges 6:33-6:40
    - What did God do for Gideon to try to stir up confidence in God's promise in verse 16?
  - Read Judges 7:7-15
    - God was ready to fight, but when was Gideon ready?
    - What does everything leading up to this point tell us about Gideon?
    - Does Gideon seem to be a valiant warrior that God called him in 6:12?
  - Read Judges 7:16-23
    - Does Gideon's actions and how they fought show us he finally trusted God's promises?
- SO WHAT?
  - What causes Christians to trust in ourselves and not fully trust God?
  - When is someone ready to be used by God?
  - Why do we test God and should we test Him?
- NOW WHAT?
  - What has fear kept you from doing that God is calling you to do?
  - What is the next step for you to show God you are ready to serve and be used by Him?
