 - What was the response of the Israelites after God said He was not going to deliver them?
 - How does God show grace to the Israelites?
 - Read Judges 10:17-11:3
 - What do we know about Jephthah?
 - Read Judges 11:4-11
 - Did God raise up Jephthah like the other judges or did the people present him to God?
 - Read Judges 11:29-40
 - What wicked vow did Jephthah make?
 - Did God just let Israel deal with their own problem or did He have grace and deliver them?

 - What does this teach us about true repentance?
 - How are the Israelites similar to us today when it comes to how we handle problems?
 - How does sin affect our relationship with God and our actions?
 - Why would Jephthah make this vow when God was already with them?
